

## HOW TO CREATE A CUSTOM CROSS-FADE UNDER KOMPAKT

*(Based on NI Kompakt Manual)*

In this tutorial, I used Gold PRO XP but it works for each product using the NI Kompakt player.

**\* Load a instance of the Kompakt player and assign it to a midi track.**



**\* Load an instrument. Here I loaded a F 6FH SUS BRIGHT.**



\* Load a second instrument. I loaded a F 6FH MUTE SUS.



\* Change the midi channel of the second instrument in order to get the same than the



**first one.**



**Now when you play a note, you should hear the two articulations playing together.**

**\* Highlight the first articulation and Click on "PITCH MOD" above the two wheels, a new window should appear.**



- \* The "Mod Destination" (the wide and last drop-down button of the new window) should be on "VOL". If it is not the case, select it.
- \* Slide the thumb of the slider control under "MODWHEEL" to the left, down to "-100%".



- \* Then Click on Exit.
- \* Highlight the second articulation, click again on "PITCHMOD" and check whether the "Mod Destination" is on "VOL".
- \* Slide the thumb of the slider control under "MODWHEEL" to the right, up to "100%".



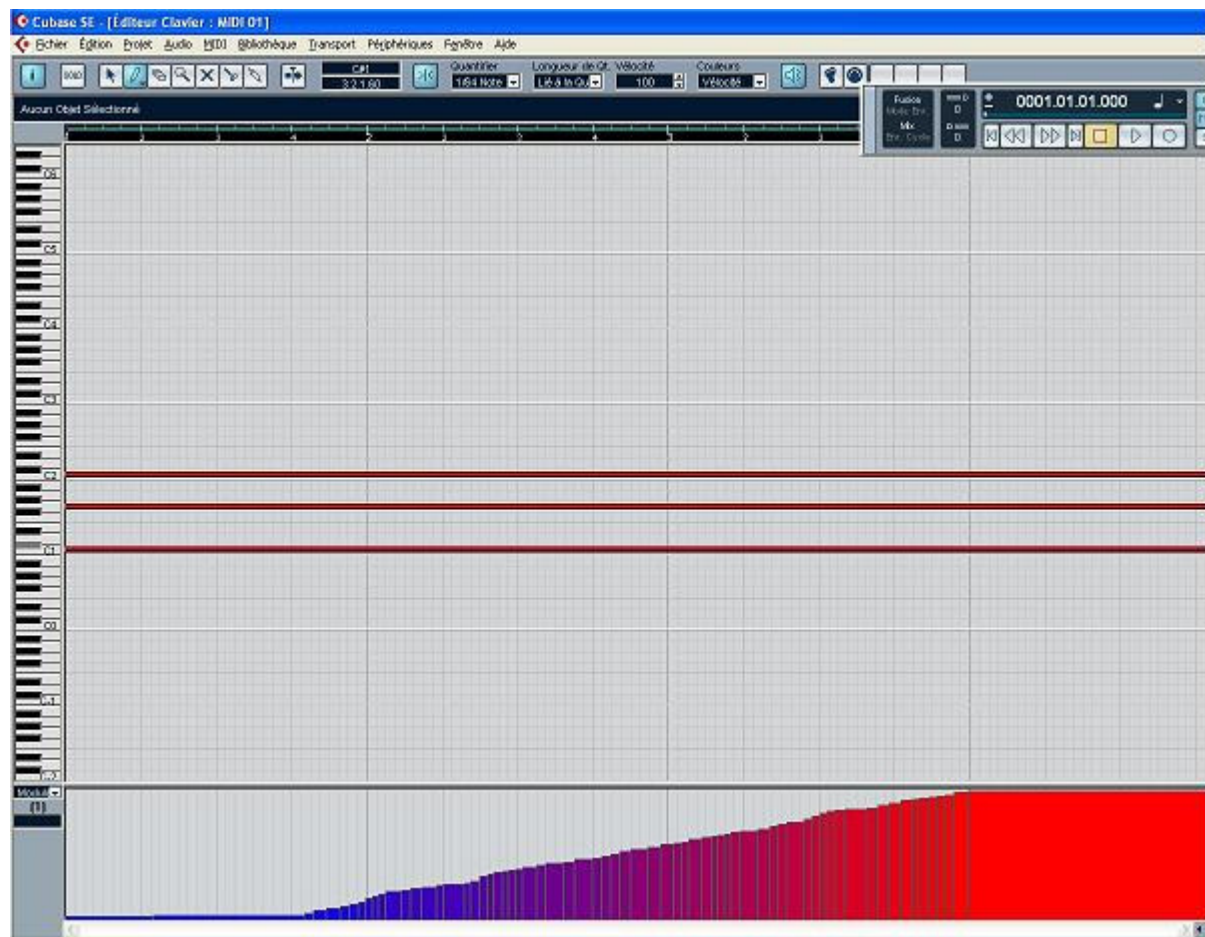
\* Click on Exit.

\* Now play with your modwheel while playing a note on your keyboard, enjoy the cross-fade !
