#### **#NOTE**

The manual "manual.pdf" located in this update is the new manual, it replaces the manual that came with the original dfh SUPERIOR box, make sure to read it.

#### **#NOTE2**

Make sure to install the VST's prior to installing the ReWire if you are going to use ReWire.

#### **#IMPORTANT NOTE**

Go to the free user area (login first at [www.toontrack.com/user/userlogin.asp](http://www.toontrack.com/user/userlogin.asp)) and get the SoundFileUpdate, it contains soundfile fixes

## **INSTALLATION**

### **SOUNDSTAT INSTALLATION:**

Follow the steps below to install the soundstat files into your library, these will minimize loading times in construction wiew.

If you are going to download and install the soundFile Update explained above (#IMPORTANT NOTE) you do not need to install the soundstats installation from this update.

#### **PC**

Drag and drop the Superior folder in this update over you Superior folder with all the sounds, if asked to overwrite, answer "yes"

#### **MacOSX**

Run the SoundStat installer in this update, destination must be your Superior folder.

## **PLUGINS INSTALL:**

### **PC - VSTi**

Naturally, make sure that you have installed all 9 DVD's and followed the instructions of the manual.

Doubleclick these files to install:

Percussionist-1.3.0.msi  
Drummer-1.3.0.msi  
Cocktail-1.3.0.msi

Install to your VSTi folder or any other folder of your choice, if you are a Cubase/Logic/Sonar or any other VSTi Host program, you will probably already have this folder specified by the installation program, if you are going to use Superior with Pro Tools or any other ReWire host, it doesn't matter where you install the VST files as long as you make sure to install the ReWire files to the same location.

### **PC - ReWire**

Double click ReWire-2.0.msi to install, make sure to install to the same directory as your VST files that you also must make sure that you have installed the latest version of.

If you are a Pro Tools user you need to copy the rewire.dll to your windows/system32 folder

## **INSTALL MacOSX**

Naturally, make sure that you have installed all 9 DVD's to the same location as described in the manual, read the file count list further down in this document to see if you've done everything correct....

### **MacOSX - VSTi**

Doubleclick "VSTi Installer 1.3.0.pkg" to install the VST's to your Library/Audio/Plug-Ins/VST folder

### **MacOSX - AU**

Doubleclick "AU Installer 1.3.0.pkg" to install to default location /components on your system drive.

### **MacOSX - ReWire**

Doubleclick the "ReWire Installer 1.3.0.pkg" to install to your library/application support folder

## REWIRE:

### Usage PC:'

Run the "SuperWireApplet.exe", enable the ReWire devices you want (all three is recommended) and quit the applet

Start your host, choose the ReWire input you want as a source

Doubleclick the appropriate Launch icon (Drummer, Cocktail, Percussionist) to start the ReWire device.

### Usage MacOSX:

Run the DFH Superior ReWire Setup applet located in the Library/Application Support, set one or more of the devices to ON. This only needs to be done once, unless you want to change something later.

Now, start your host... the DFHS outputs will be available as ReWire sources.

Finally, once you selected a source, doubleclick the "Launch ReWire" icon or the appropriate module (so, if you selected the drummer, doubleclick the Launch for the drummer).

## KNOWN BUGS:

Changing to 'Always on top' when editing a value causes a crash.

If you are using DP with AU you may experience a redraw bug, if so, click the drummer-1 menu in the upper left corner and select track8 or something, then choose drummer1 again.
